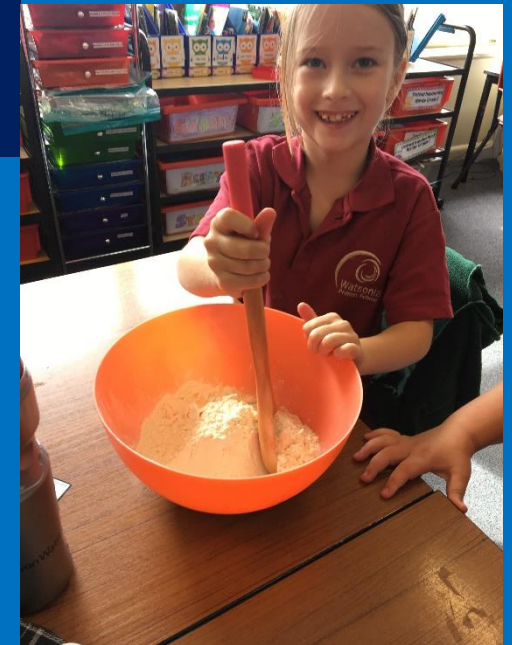

Playdough

Ingredients:

- 2 cups plain flour
- 2 tablespoons vegetable oil
- 1/2 cup salt
- 2 tablespoons cream of tartar
- 1-1.5 cups hot water
- food colouring

Equipment:

- Mixing bowl
- Wooden spoon
- Measuring cups and spoons

Method:

- Mix the flour, salt, cream of tartar and oil in a large mixing bowl
- Add food colouring to the boiling water then pour into the dry ingredients
- Stir continuously until it becomes a sticky, combined dough
- Take the playdough out of the bowl and knead it vigorously for a couple of minutes until all of the stickiness has gone.
