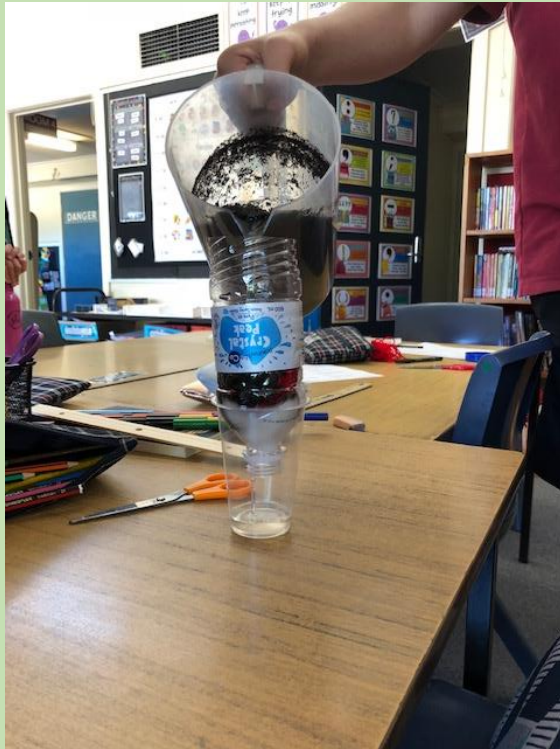


# 5/6 RK STEM
