



Dear Parents/Guardians,

Welcome back to school for a busy Term 2. We hope you enjoyed the holiday break.

The Term 2 Grade 3-6 **Inquiry** unit will have a focus on rules, laws and the different levels of parliament in Australia. This unit will culminate in an excursion into the city early in Term 3; more information will come home later this term.

The 3-6 **Showcase**, celebrating Maths, will be held on **Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> June at 9.10-9.45** in rooms 1, 2 and 3. June **Student Reports** will be available to view and/or download through Compass on Friday 21<sup>st</sup> June. Three way conference bookings will be open on Compass midway through Term 2 and our three way conferences are on Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> June.

All students in grade 4-6 will participate in the winter **interschool sports** program each week. The sports for term 2 are Football and Netball. It is important that all students wear strong footwear (runners) for sports sessions. Students in the football team must also wear a mouthguard for matches. The permission form and payment should have been returned to school last term.

In Term 1, some of the local secondary schools visited Watsonia to talk about their programs. This week, all grade 6 students will bring home the **Year 7 Transition** information and an application for secondary school enrolment. This form must be returned to school no later than **Friday 17<sup>th</sup> May**. It is important that parents complete the whole form appropriately. Please see Miss Wright if you have any questions.

The **Events Planner** contains details of the many other important school events this term.

**Home Learning** will continue to be a weekly expectation this term. Home Learning activities are based on classroom learning. Grade 3-6 students will be expected to complete and submit their Home Learning by Friday every week. The Home Learning planner outlines the tasks in detail but in summary, your child will be expected to read nightly, complete the maths practise task from the schedule provided and learn their set spelling words. It is of vital importance for students to read nightly. Students can read books borrowed from their classroom, the school library or novels from home. Students will also be reading each day at school. Students are required to log their home reading in their school diary or home learning book.

Our Year 3-6 **camp** to Phillip Island Adventure Resort will be held in October. If you would like your child to attend camp a deposit of \$50 is required by **Friday 21<sup>st</sup> June**.

Grade 3 & 5 students will be completing the **NAPLAN** tests beginning Tues 14<sup>th</sup> May, finishing Thurs 16<sup>th</sup> May.

There will be occasions when you will receive notices to sign and/or money to pay for events. Please ensure that you return these by the due dates listed. Electronic payments can be made at the office and all other payments must go to the classroom teacher.

Some students are using their **school diaries** as a great resource for writing in reminders and for their home learning and daily reading. School diaries should be coming to school every day. Please encourage your child so we can help them to develop good habits as they move towards secondary school.

Please remember that school starts each day at 9.00am. If students arrive later than 9.00am, they must visit the office first to sign in and receive a late pass which they give to their classroom teacher. If your child is absent, please log their absence through Compass. Absences are officially recorded as approved if notification is received and unapproved if we receive no notification from parents.

It would be appreciated if your child could bring a box of tissues to share with the class each term.

### Must Do:

### Can Do:

**If you wish to further extend your learning, you can also spend 20-30 minutes a few times a week completing some of the following activities:**

- Reading Eggs (Your username and password can be found in your Home Learning book)
- Mathletics (Your username and password can be found in your Home Learning book)
- Practicing skip counting patterns or times tables.
- Free reading (Choose any books of your choice)
