Visual Arts

Grade Prep - 3: Students will be exploring a range of art materials and techniques, working on their own individual expression. Students will be engaging in a unit based on illustrators, learning about their techniques and how to recreate their own versions.

Grade 4 – 6: Students will be working on developing their artistic skills to develop really high quality work. This term, students will engage in a range of projects, such as ‘The traveling Midnight Alpaca’, and a ‘Splattered Painted Wolf’. These projects will take several weeks to complete, as students learn about a new process of making art.

Performing Arts

Grade Prep: Students will enjoy singing songs, exploring music and movement, and have some fun playing percussion instruments; exploring rhythm and beat.

Grade 1 - 3: Students will begin a unit on the fundamental elements of music. They will get to play instruments, learn songs and dance routines. Students will also develop their understanding between mindfulness, music and yoga.
